## GETTING TO PRINCE RUPERT Commercial Flights

Guests must arrive at Prince Rupert the day before their trip as only one commercial flight through Air Canada arrives daily at Prince Rupert Airport at 2:57 pm. From the Airport, you will board a bus provided by Air Canada to travel from Digby Island (Airport) via ferry to downtown Prince Rupert.

## TRAVELING TO EAGLE POINTE LODGE

To Travel from Prince Rupert to Eagle Pointe Lodge, you will depart Prince Rupert from West Coast Launch (205 Cow Bay Road, Atlin Dock). Please plan to arrive at West Coast Launch by 12:45 pm to depart on the Digby Island water taxi at 1:00 pm. You will arrive at Digby Dock and travel by van to the Prince Rupert Airport located on Digby Island. At the Airport, please check in with HeliJet at 1:45 pm to take a scenic 20-minute helicopter flight to Eagle Pointe Lodge. When you arrive at Eagle Pointe Lodge, you will be greeted by our staff for a quick introduction, then you will pack a lunch and head out fishing for the afternoon. Should you need to make alternate travel arrangements that differ from the above, please contact us at 1-888-988-8388 for further information. Additional costs will apply.

## **RETURNING TO PRINCE RUPERT**

On departure day from Eagle Pointe Lodge, following your return from early morning fishing, we will serve you lunch at 12:30 pm. Guests can anticipate departing Eagle Pointe Lodge at 2:30 pm and arrive in Prince Rupert at 2:50 pm and arriving at Prince Rupert Airport at 2:50 pm. Air Canada departs Prince Rupert Airport at 3:40 pm. We recommend booking your flights as soon as possible to avoid delays. Please confirm luggage weight restrictions.
